Dear potential parent/s

Here at The Tutor Hub Learning Centre our vision and goal is to offer home school support in a safe and child-centered environment. Our professional team focuses on the individual needs of each child whilst working through the curriculum outcomes. We strive to create a warm, friendly and co-operative environment where strong values, core skills and understanding are nurtured.

We believe that all parents have the right to choose how their children are schooled and we are here to support in any way we can by ensuring that quality instruction and scholastic support is given outside of their home environment. If your child is not coping with the demands of main stream schooling, or just has different needs, The Tutor Hub Learning Centre is the perfect place for you. We provide academic support to learners who have chosen to complete a CAPS based curriculum. Our morning classes are focused on supporting learners from **Grade One to Grade Nine**.

As we are still a small focused team, we are able to work on a one-to-one basis with our learners. We are not time or assessment driven and therefore exercise great patience with the students thereby allowing them to progress at a comfortable pace. We tutor according to the chosen curriculum and all of the work, assessments and tests are done at the Centre, homework will only be sent home if we feel it is very necessary.

We follow a WCED school term calendar and we will have holiday slots and aftercare available upon request. We do have internet access but we **do not** provide learners with computers or devices.

Learning does not just happen in a classroom and therefore we aim to plan outings and involve our learners in community enrichment such as participating in outreach programs. We would also like to offer extra programs like visual art, emotional development and movement lessons during our school week to give learners a break from academics.

We are Christian based and work towards encouraging Christian values in our children. Learners do not wear school uniforms and parents are responsible for their meals and snacks. We follow a structured yet flexible daily program and expect our learners to behave in a disciplined manner and respect each other's academic time. If a learner displays disruptive behaviour that has a negative effect on the group, we reserve the right to ask that parent to make alternative arrangements for their child.

The emotional well-being and safety of our staff & learners are of the utmost importance to us, so while we try to accommodate all children, we always base our decisions on that.

We are based at the Dutch Reformed Church in Somerset West, on the corner of Andries Pretorius and Dirkie Uys Street. Our Centre hours are from **07:45 to 12:45** (Monday to Friday). We have an additional learning support or remedial slots available from 12:45 to 13:30 at an extra cost. Take note that the SA Schools Act specifies that home education only applies where children are educated in his or her own home. I encourage parents to officially enroll their child as a homeschooler at the WCED and complete the required forms.

Parents who are interested should download and complete our pre-enrolment form. We want to encourage you to arrange a meeting with our team leader Aloës Koegelenberg so that further details can be discussed. We are interested in hearing your story and helping you to find a solution that fits your family's needs. Mainstream education is not the only schooling option. Find what works for your child as everyone is unique. We would love for you to allow us to support your child on this journey.

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2022 and 2023 Pricing:

Fees are always payable by the 1st of each month or the starting date of a new term. Unpaid fees will result in a student losing their spot. There is a once off **registration fee of R850** for new students.

Upon acceptance, parents will receive a list of required stationery, textbooks and/or workbooks (depending on the chosen curriculum). This will be purchased by The Tutor Hub at PNA and added on the monthly invoice. A lot of the required work will be printed at our centre. Aftercare and/or extra support is available upon request and will be charged at an hourly rate.
