Just as there are different colours in the rainbow, there are children with unique and different learning requirements. The Tutor Hub Independent School aims to serve and create a learning environment for those learners that are looking for something different than a mainstream school.

At The Tutor Hub Independent School we choose to follow a CAPS based curriculum that is child focused and based on the milestones that should be reached according to South African school standards. While we are CAPS based, we also incorporate other successful material in our day-to-day tasks.

We believe in developing core skills in languages and mathematics and laying down solid foundations for learning. Our learners are assessed every term according to the WCED curriculum requirements and will receive termly progress reports. At The Tutor Hub we make use of informal (continuous) assessment as well as formal assessment tasks. We will always strive to create an "anxiety-free" test environment for our learners as we know that learners can't achieve their true potential if they feel anxious.

Our class groups are small as our goal is to give enough one-on-one attention to learners who might have special needs or require a child-centered learning approach. We will also try to challenge our learners to think critically and become more independent and confident in their daily learning. Small class groups allow us the opportunity to see each child's potential and also to address any learning barriers that might occur. We have learning support teachers on staff so that extra remedial lessons can take place during our school day should any learners require such assistance.

To enrich our learners, parents are required to purchase a specific book box (carefully chosen by our team) to support the core CAPS curriculum. The Tutor Hub will charge a termly printing fee to ensure learners receive assessments, worksheets and additional learning material throughout the year. When it comes to homework, we do not believe in overwhelming learners with unnecessary homework. We do however, believe in practicing and consolidating certain skills at home such as reading and preparing for assessments and that will involve the co-operation of our parents.
